Practice Overview

Stephen Gilmore is Professor of Family Law and a Vice-Dean in the School of Law at King's College London. He is joint Editor of *Child and Family Law Quarterly* and an editorial advisor for the *Family Court Reports* (UK). From September 2023, he will be Professor of Family Law at the University of Cambridge and Director of Cambridge Family Law.

Stephen has written across a range of issues in Family Law, with a particular interest in the law of parental responsibility, post-separation parenting arrangements and children's rights. He is co-author of *Children The Modern Law* (4th ed., Family Law), of five editions of a major family law text *Hayes and Williams' Family Law* (Oxford University Press), and of two editions of *Great Debates in Family Law* (Palgrave Macmillan). He is editor of *Parental Rights and Responsibilities* (Routledge) in the *Library of Essays on Family Rights* series. He is also co-editor of *Family Matters - Essays in Honour of John Eekelaar* (Intersentia), *Re-writing Children's Rights Judgments: From Academic Vision to New Practice* (Hart Publishing), *Landmark Cases in Family Law* (Hart Publishing) and *Responsible Parents and Parental Responsibility* (Hart Publishing).
